1. Who are we?

Haadibadi is a non-profit organisation located in Bangalore working across different states.

2. What do we do?

Haadibadi Theatre works with schoolchildren and adults, training them in the theatre, art, awareness programmes, personality development programmes, etc. To know more (Link)

3. Is the community library open now?

The community library has been temporarily shut down due to the COVID crisis until further notice.
